
Point of Care Tools

BMJ Best Practice provides high quality clinical decision support with a good breadth of coverage and evidence-based methodology. It links to BNF and BNFc. It is available via NHS Evidence, or the Library page on K-Net. OpenAthens access. If you create a personal account you can then access BMJ Best Practice outside the hospital, download the app and track activity to record CME/CPD points.

NICE Evidence is the site that gives the simplest access to our journal and database resources.



NICE Evidence search accesses freely available information from a variety of sources: e.g. NICE, Government, professional bodies, charities and patient groups, Cochrane. It is a useful source of summarized clinical information.

Filters allow you to narrow the results by a variety of criteria e.g. evidence type, date, publication type, source ...

Accessing journals via NICE Evidence

1. To access the NHS Athens resources type https://www.evidence.nhs.uk into the address bar of your browser:

2. Select Journals and Databases

Scroll down to Journals A-Z and login with your OpenAthens details.

4. Search for a journal by selecting words in title' and putting in or all of the title.



HDAS - Healthcare Databases Advanced Search

Healthcare Databases Advanced Search (HDAS) is an integrated search interface to the major medical and healthcare databases subscribed to by NICE. You can find journal articles from a wide range of titles, *linked to full text papers where possible*. **NICE** Healthcare Databases

3. Select the HDAS link and login with your OpenAthens details.

eBooks

1. Go to the KGH Library Catalogue at https://kgh.koha-ptfs.co.uk (you do not need to login to view our catalogue)

2. Select 'Advanced search' -

3. Select your search terms - Title, author, keywords, Call number (eg. WV for ENT books)


4. Select 'Item Type' - 'ebook'


5. Click 'Search'
