In retiring from the position of Medical Attendant to the Kettering Dispensary, I need hardly say how reluctantly I do it. - For forty years it has been a source of great interest to me, and not a little instruction. -

During that term a fund of £1000 has been

gradually built up, which now becomes available towards establishing an endowment fund for our long wished for "Kettering & District General Hospital". -

The interest on £650 of this fund is now in use for endowment purposes in general, and the interest of £355<sup>is</sup> from this time to be applied to the Kettering Dispensary, Surgical Appliances fund at the Hospital, "A much needed fund". - These amounts are out on mortgage in my name as trustee, and the securities are in the hands of Messrs G. H. Lamb & Stringer.

And now I have to thank (which I most cordially do) the kind & generous supporters of the late dispensary, through a long period of years, for all their acts of kindness to the institution, which has lasted now nearly a hundred years
