

1924. A couch in the physiotherapy department at the Kettering General Hospital showing the early types of heat lamps. This was known as "Artificial Sunlight Exposure".






Dr. Leslie Winter Dryland 1834–1906 Honorary Surgeon to the Kettering General Hospital.
