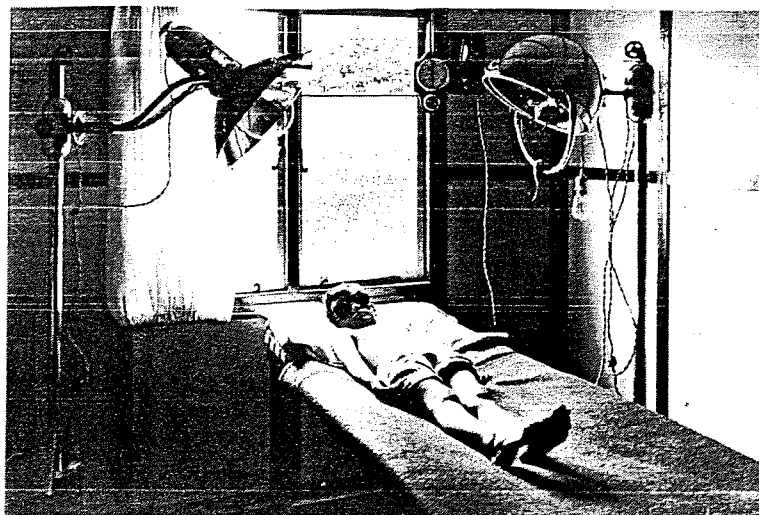


1924. A couch in the physiotherapy department at the Kettering General Hospital showing the early types of heat lamps. This was known as "Artificial Sunlight Exposure".



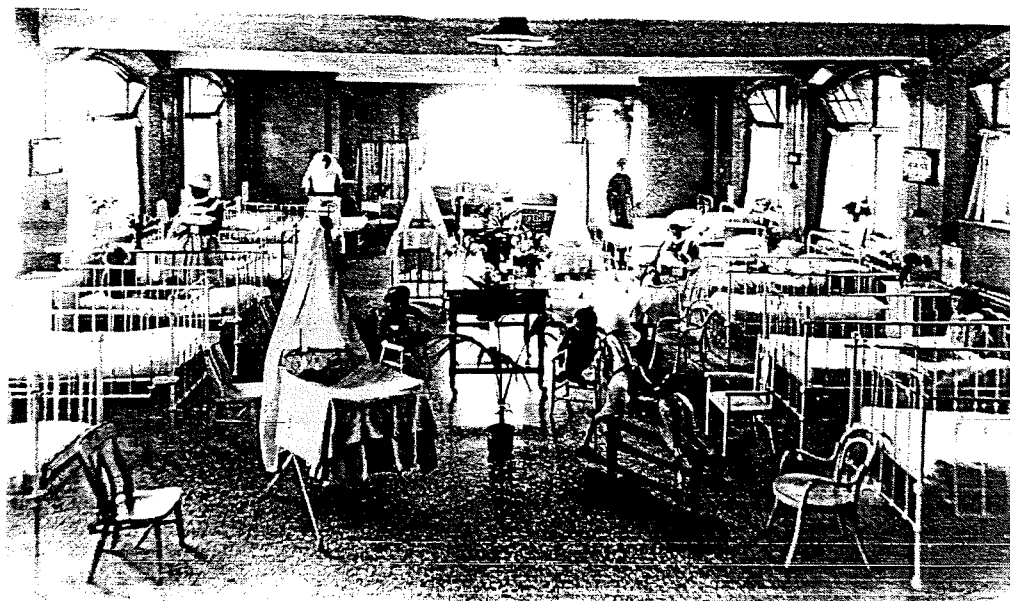
