

RULES

1. TITLE. The Club is to be called Kettering Hospital Cricket Club.
2. MEMBERSHIP. Membership is confined to employees of the Kettering & District Hospital Management Committee, ex-employees remaining in the Health Service and up to six guest players approved by the Executive Committee.
3. YEAR-END & A.G.M. The Financial Year end will be on 31st October and the Annual General Meeting be held within six weeks of that date.
4. SUBSCRIPTIONS. Subscriptions for membership to be 5s.0d. per season.
5. OFFICERS & MANAGEMENT. The officers of the Club shall consist of President, Vice-Presidents, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Captain and Vice-Captain. The Executive Committee shall consist of Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Captain, Vice-Captain and two other members. The Selection Committee shall consist of Captain, Vice-Captain and one other member. The Ancillary Officers of the Club shall be Umpires, Scorers, Transport Officer, Catering Officer and Kit Keepers. All Officers to be elected at the Annual General Meeting.

6. AUDITORS. Two Auditors to be elected at the Annual General Meeting.
7. BANK. The Bank shall be the Trustees Saving Bank for current account. Investments at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
8. COLOURS. The Colours of the Club shall be Royal Blue.
9. EMERGENCY GENERAL MEETING. An Emergency General Meeting may be called at the request of six or more members, provided that nine days notice is given.
10. ALTERATION TO RULES. Rules may only be altered at an Emergency General Meeting or the Annual General Meeting.
