MIDWIFERY AND MATERNITY CASES.

In the register of cases provided in accordance with the Rules of the Central Midwives Board the midwife is asked to record the name of the doctor if called. I should be glad, however, if for all cases attended from 1st January, 1957 you would show the following information in the column headed "Name of doctor if called".

Name of doctor booked.

Whether present at delivery.

If not present at delivery whether doctor attended during confinement. (state stage)

If not present during confinement whether doctor attended during puerperium.

If the doctor did not attend at any time during confinement or puerperium this should be stated.

Later on in the year I shall be asking you to let me have your register so that information on this subject can be extracted in the office.
