- (i) The following subparagraphs shall be substituted for Rule B. 4 (a) (ii):—

(a) (ii) if her name appears on the part of the Register of the General Nursing Council for England and Wales, the General Nursing Council for Scotland, the Joint Nursing and Midwives Council for Northern Ireland, or An Bord Altranais, Eire, containing the names of nurses trained in the nursing and care of persons suffering from infectious diseases; or in the part thereof containing the names of nurses trained in the nursing and care of persons suffering from mental diseases; or in the separate section of the last-mentioned part thereof as trained in the nursing and training of the mentally defective, by virtue of having passed the Examination of one of those Bodies or some other Examination recognized by the General Nursing Council for England and Wales, and she has had the required period of training which may from time to time be recognized by the General Nursing Council for England and Wales, evidence, satisfactory to the Board, that she has fulfilled these requirements; or
