Dear Madam,

I have much pleasure in informing you that your application for registration has been approved and your name has now been entered on the part of the Register for *General Nurses* maintained by the General Nursing Council for England and Wales. Your registration number is 290405 and you are now entitled to call yourself a Registered Nurse; your date of registration is 28th November 1960.

Your certificate of registration will be forwarded in due course to your permanent address; I would however point out that the certificate has to be engrossed and sealed, and some time must therefore elapse before it is ready to be issued. In the meantime, you may use this letter as evidence of your registration having been effected.

A uniform permit is enclosed herewith, and your State Registered Badge will be sent to you direct from the manufacturers; owing to restrictions in supplies of metal and shortage of labour there is at present a delay of approximately six months in the manufacture and issue of the badges, and it is unlikely that the position will improve for some time. When you receive the badge great care should be taken of it in order that it may not fall into the hands of any unauthorised person; it is the property of the Council and arrangements should be made for its return to these offices on the death of a nurse. The loss of a badge should be notified at once.

I am asked to emphasise that it is the duty of every Registered Nurse to notify to the Council any change of permanent address, and it is earnestly hoped that you will not fail to carry out this duty towards the Council. A change of name by marriage or otherwise should also be notified, and in such case the necessary documents (marriage certificate or deed poll) must be submitted. These will be returned by registered post.

In all correspondence with this office please give your full name and quote your registration number given in this letter.
