period of training which may from time to time be recognized by the General Nursing Council for England and Wales, evidence, satisfactory to the Board, that she has fulfilled these requirements; or

- (iv) if her name appears on the Register of the Chartered Society of Physiotherapy and she has passed the Final Examination for the Orthopaedic Nursing Certificate; or if she holds a certificate of the British Tuberculosis Association, having in these cases completed the recognized period of training, evidence, satisfactory to the Board, that she has fulfilled these requirements; or
- (v) in any other case, evidence satisfactory to the Board as to the general education which she has had;
- (ii) The following Rule shall be substituted for Rule B.11:—
- 11. The first period of training shall extend over 6 consecutive calendar months in the case of pupils to whom Rule B. 4 (a) (i) applies; over 12 consecutive calendar months in the case of pupils to whom Rules B. 4 (a) (ii), (iii) and (iv) apply and over 18 consecutive calendar months in all other cases.
- (iii) The following Rule shall be substituted for Rule B.13.:—
  - 13. (a) A pupil whose first period of training extends over 12 consecutive calendar months shall during such period—
    - (i) attend a course of at least 38 lectures extending over a period of not less than 6 calendar months and otherwise complying with Rule B. 12 (a); such lectures to be supplemented by practical demonstrations and tutorial classes;
    - (ii) conduct antenatal examinations and receive instruction in accordance with Rule B. 12 (b);
