

- (iii) receive clinical instruction in the conduct of labour, including the witnessing of not less than 20 labours;
  - (iv) attend not less than 10 labours in accordance with the provisions of Rule B. 12 (*d*);
  - (v) attend and nurse not less than 40 lying-in women and their infants during the time the patients are in the approved training institution.
- (b) A pupil whose first period of training extends over 18 consecutive calendar months shall during a period extending over not less than the first six months of her training—
- (i) receive theoretical and practical instruction in the elementary principles of general nursing, the use of nursing appliances and the methods of taking and recording the pulse-rate, the temperature and the respiration rate;
  - (ii) attend a course of theoretical and practical instruction in general anatomy, and in the physiology and hygiene of the mother and infant.
- (c) A pupil whose first period of training extends over 18 consecutive calendar months shall during the succeeding period of her training receive instruction in accordance with Rule B. 13 (*a*).

#### **Amendments to Section E of the Principal Rules**

In Rules E. 12, 25 and 35: (i) in paragraphs (*c*), (*d*) and (*e*) of each of the said rules, for the words "on her own responsibility" there shall be substituted the words "except on the instructions and in the presence of a registered medical practitioner"; (ii) in paragraph (*c*) of each of the said rules, for the word "except" there shall be substituted the words "otherwise than"; and (iii) in paragraph (*f*) of each of the said rules, for the words "under the personal direction and supervision" there shall be substituted the words "on the instructions and in the presence".
