It helps people from across the NHS by providing them with easy access to high quality evidence-based information including guidelines, primary research and ongoing trials.

Sources include: British National Formulary, SIGN, the Cochrane Library and Royal Colleges.

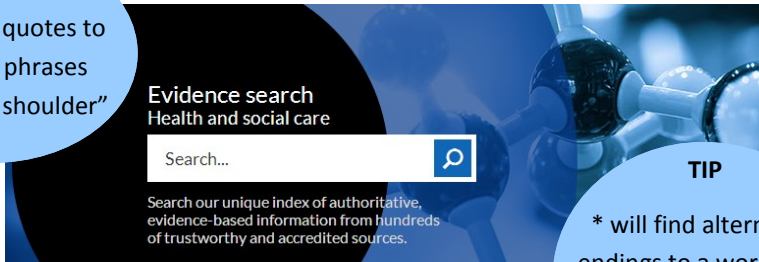

Step 1: Think about your question

What are the keywords? Are there alternative terms for your topic?

TIP

Use double quotes to find exact phrases
e.g. "frozen shoulder"



TIP

* will find alternative endings to a word stem
e.g. cannul* will find cannula and


Type in relevant terms hit **Enter** or click the Search button.


Plurals are searched automatically e.g. pregnancy will find pregnancies

Step 2: View your results

Click on the title for full text links or click **Read Summary** to help determine usefulness.

Use **OR** when you want either of two alternative terms in your results e.g. asthma OR eczema

Step 3: Refine your search
