

'Exam', 'Surgery' & Obs & Gynae unsold titles are available on the 'free to a good home' tables in the comfy seating area.


## Quiet Study/Private 1-2-1 Conversation Rooms



The next meeting of the KGH Book Club will be on: – **Wed 18th January, 1-1.45pm in The Zone**


We will be sharing **The Unlikely Pilgrimage of Harold Fry** by **Rachel Joyce**
